



## Our Commitment to the Environment

Environmental issues are becoming increasingly important worldwide, and we all have a duty to do our part to protect our future. To save our ecosystem we need to take responsibility for our personal and business activities.

Here at Nadivana we pride ourselves in our commitment to creating a cleaner environment. We are constantly searching for ways of improving our environmental performance and reducing the impact that our activities and services have on the environment. Throughout our operations initiatives in saving the environment is always a priority and we value any contribution, assistance or suggestion you provide.

To ensure that we do our part in protecting our future, here are some of our commitments:

1. Using less energy means real savings for our environment. Our card key switch helps us significantly reduce energy consumption in empty hotel rooms. Whether it's for comfort, safety or just a response to the unfamiliar surroundings, hotel rooms are notorious for being lit and air conditioned while unoccupied. To stem this unnecessary waste of energy, the 2006 IECC and ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1 both require all new hospitality rooms to include a master switch or control device at the main entry that controls permanently installed lighting and switched receptacles throughout the room. Our card key switch easily complies with current energy codes, saves on utility bills and improves guest comfort and convenience – all by providing a simple way to turn the room's controlled lighting on or off at once when entering or exiting a room.

About 90% of the energy used in Nadivana is in the guest apartments. Studies show that hotel lighting usage patterns do not reflect a significant dip in energy consumption during 11 A.M. to 5 P.M. when guest rooms are typically unoccupied. Rather, researchers have found that guest room lights are on 20-25% of the time during this time period.

Nadivana's Card Key Switches positively impact the energy management behavior of our staff and guests without the need for any special training, offering a significant opportunity to achieve maximum environmental savings.

2. We have introduced procedures for all waste to be disposed of appropriately. We recycle all paper, glass, cans, plastic, batteries, cups, cardboard and toner cartridges. Recycled products are used where possible.
3. All our waste water is cleaned internally and reused for watering purposes throughout the property.
4. All towels left on the floor are washed and replaced every day. Towels left hanging will be left for another day of use.
5. We will change all your bed sheets every day during your stay with us. If you feel that this is excessive and unnecessary, you can signal the maid and delay the changing until the following day. On your bedroom door handle there is a sign; red signals the maid to delay the changing, while green tells her to change the sheets.
